From the Pastor's Desk

Rev Brian Bagley Bonner



Why Co-Pastoring?

In November the Pastoral Relations Committee introduced a concept of my wife, Jude, and I sharing the position of Pastor of Faith UCC. There are two main reasons for this. First, Jude and I will benefit from more time to renew and feed our creative sides. The Family and Work Institute's **When Work Works- 2008 Guide to Bold New Ideas for Marking Work Work** states it clearly. People share a job...in order to create time for a more balanced, integrated life, where they have time to pursue other areas such as avocation, family, self-care practices, or other interests. Employees, who equally invest in their work and in the rest of their lives, are among the most committed and productive. The Nation's top employers are continuing to create effective and flexible workplaces, especially during these times of volatility and change."

One of the other benefits to us is that Jude will be able to spend significant time in the summer with her mother and other family in Ohio. During those times I will remain here and do the whole job. We actually shared a Pastorate in the 90's at a congregation in Minnesota which brings us to the second reason to consider Co-Pastoring: because Faith UCC will benefit. The book, **Job Sharing: Two Heads Are Better Than One** by Mary O'Hanlon and Angela Morella says this, ... *Two minds working together will usually achieve more creative, high quality results. Employers get two*

people with different skills and experiences in a single position, broadening the capabilities of their workforce.... Burnout drops and productivity increases because each employee comes in fresh for their half of the job. Some managers of job-share teams notice that they are more organized and strategic about their work because they have to explain what they've accomplished in order to keep the job share partner informed.

The congregation in Minnesota often expressed that they benefitted greatly as both of us were able to "Play to our strengths." Having two distinct pastoral personalities made for more creative worship and programming and having two different leadership styles also expanded the number of people who found a particular style helpful. Thankfully, Jude and I worked together well, and had a good "energy" to our collaboration which spilled over to the congregation.

If we proceed with the plan, the transition will be done slowly, with Jude taking on areas like new programming and specific church growth activities. I will continue to do everything I am doing now including emergency calls. The only exception is one Sunday a month Jude will preach (maybe twice in months with five Sundays). Below are other aspects of the plan:

- To help the transition, Brian and Jude will start to make some hospital visits together.
- When Jude is gone for the summer, she will stay in touch by doing some midweek messages,

maybe Skype a sermon, etc.

- When both are in Florida, we will both attend Council and Sunday morning worship (with a few exceptions).
- Regarding vacation and sabbatical: Both are to be handled as for one pastor, ie: if one pastor gets 3 months sabbatical, then Jude and Brian get three months together. Same for vacation, there will be 4 weeks where we hire pulpit fill and get emergency cover when they are both on vacation. There will be times when only one is doing the job, but all aspects of the work will be covered by that person at those times.

In January we are going to have some informal Question and Answer times after service on a couple of Sundays and also one Saturday morning. Please plan to attend one of these to find out more.

It is truly a joy to be a part of Faith UCC. I am excited about our pressing forward together. Our Dreams and Visions are coming ever closer to our lived reality! May God continue to help us be the Light of the World and the Salt of the Earth.

There are lots of upcoming opportunities for fellowship, good food, fun, and laughter so if you are interested we would love to have you participate.



CHURCH COUNCIL MEETING
Faith United Church of Christ
December 8, 2014

In attendance: Judy Wetter, Brian Bagley-Bonner, Faith Quici, Fred Damianos, Sheryl Overheidt Smith, Richard Dilts, Marge Critelli, Marge Hooie, Robin Wentz, Deb D'Angelo

Meeting started at 7:05pm
Babs opened in prayer.

Financial Secretary: reported that we have 31 pledges turned in and last year at this time we had 34 pledges. She noted that some of the regular winter folks are not here yet and she and Judy agreed to work together to contact those who regularly pledge and have not been heard from yet.

Treasurer: Shared the budget report and stated that we are in good shape despite the higher expenses this year. In the next report it will show the internal borrowing of the money that was transferred from the "Thorntons Money" to the checking account to cover bills.

Pastor: There a couple of new member prospects and he will be speaking to them individually. Sundays are going well and there was a full group for the study on Buddhism. Looking forward to doing more electronic outreach in the new year (social media). Christmas Eve service will be at 7pm this year after tallying up the total from the Christmas Eve Service survey. There was talk about incorporating more opportunities throughout the year for meditation in the Sunday morning service.

Secretary: reported that things are going smoothly and to please indicate any upcoming events on the calendar for December and January. She reminded the council that Annual Reports are due at the next council meeting, January 12. Also an end of year report of all office happenings was passed out.

New Business:

Dinner and Dessert: Friday, December 19 at 6pm is Dinner and Dessert. It's at Ruby Tuesday on University and Deb D'Angelo is hosting the dessert at her home. The next Dinner and Dessert will be January 16 and the Groth's have agreed to host. A dining establishment to gather is yet to be determined.

Auction: Pictures are posted online. There are currently over 65 items up for auction. Flyers have been created,

posted and distributed. In the process of getting local press coverage.

Stewardship: Operating pledge thus far is \$69,798. Last year at this time we had a pledge budget of \$72,749. Reminder letters will be sent out this week for those we haven't heard from. Building for the future fund will be made clearer and talked about more often to the congregation. Sunday, December 14, is the last day to order and pay for poinsettias.

Pastoral Relations Committee: Last meeting was December 3. The committee worked out bugs in the copastorate and discussed making it clearer on it "looks like" to make it a good balance. Want to make sure everyone knows who the Pastor is. Working on a way to get to know Jude more, possibly through small groups, church growth preaching one of the four Sundays a month, handle emergency calls, hospital visits together, midweek message, both attend council, both at service. Make it clear it's two people but one pastorate. Goal is for everyone to be fully aware before voting. Some info Q&A meetings planned possibly for Sun, Jan 11 and 18 and also Sat 17th. PRC members have decided to stay in their positions another year. Nominating Committee: So far the 2015 council is looking for, Co-lead for Fellowship Events team to help out Sheryl who said she would stay on if she had help, Building and Grounds, Moderator.

Mission Money: All of Thorntons money from the sale of the land, is in a money market now. No further decisions have been made but the financial committee will make a recommendation next meeting.

NEW BUSINESS:

2015 Budget: It was suggested to create a separate pass through account for projector light bulbs so that the money will be available when they need to be replaced. Discussed financial accountability and transparency. Marge Critelli will bring her computer to the next meeting so we have a live report of the budget. Marge will meet with volunteers in the church who know budgets and finance to help her compile the 2015 Budget in time for the annual reports and meeting.

Pastor Brian's potential 7/8's time will be up to the congregation to decide. Ideas about church growth, a musician, full time pastor and volunteers were shared.

Life touch committee for church photo directory will be – Judy, Sheryl, Deb, Cindy and Babs. Sign up for photo appointments needs to start no later than January 4 and picture days are Tues and Wed, Jan 27 & 28 from 2:30-8:30pm both days. Volunteers for greeters are needed these days.

DEPARTMENTS:

Building and Grounds: Work day was a great success with 18 people showing up to help out. Much was accomplished. Year to date \$967 has been donated towards building and grounds and credited in giving. Sidewalks and palms trimmed are up next on the agenda.

Christian Ed: No youth Sunday School anymore. It will be cancelled from the schedule and calendar.

Events: Women's Tea went well with 17 shoeboxes made and donated to our Christmas all church mission this year and invited to Ranch Grille for a reception. Potluck will be Sunday! Really need dishes to share. A reminder will go up on the screens on Sunday. Also Potluck will be on Jan 18 instead of 2nd Sunday due to the Auction the day before.

Community: Communicated with Observer about the Auction
SAM: Christmas fund posters going up and being advertised next 2 Sunday's with a collection on Sunday, Dec 21.

SLT: Doris Gerlach is home. Bob and Jean watching and waiting on his condition. Making sure Katie Leonard on the prayer line for her illness.

Worship: Richard reported that Poinsettias are being delivered on Wed, Jan 17. The candles are ready for Christmas Eve service.

Communion (Jan 4) volunteers from council include: Richard, Babs, Fred, Judy, Sheryl and Robin. Need a scripture reader.

Meeting adjourned at 10pm with a closing prayer by Pastor Brian.
