## FROM YOUR MODERATOR

## <u>Update from Kids Against Hunger</u>

As most of you will remember, Faith UCC sponsors Sunrise Kiwanis's Kids Against Hunger events and have often sent a team of our members to help with the packing of meals. Since COVID hit, we have not been able to attend but they sent us this update. SAM will be considering a donation in the next month......AND Please keep all these wonderful, caring people in your prayers.

"We have been able to package over 60,000 meals this year. This is way down from the 170,000 meals we packaged in 2019. But all meals we have done have been distributed right here in Manatee County to organizations like Feeding Empty Little Tummies and Our Daily Bread.

Although we are not able to hold large scale events like in the past, we have been able to begin doing smaller events at our warehouse. These events are made possible by our generous donors and they are the ones who also volunteer to come and pack the meals.

We are following strict guidelines for the safety of those who attend our events."

## **UPCOMING OFFERINGS**

We will be collecting a special offering on Sunday November 22 for Habitat for Humanity. We do this yearly as part of our involvement with the community efforts of Habitat for Humanity.

In December, we will collect a special offering for "The Christmas Fund," formerly known as Veterans of the Cross, to help support retired UCC pastors.

### **Looking for volunteer Zoom Greeters:**

As we continue with our online church services, one of the things we are missing is our greeters. During our in person services, these individuals would welcome and greet attendees as they arrived. We would like to see this continue during our Zoom services. Our online greeters would sign on about 10:10 and personally greet each person as they sign on. ### **Advent**

Advent begins on the last Sunday in November. The worship leaders will be back in the sanctuary and we will be adding new Christmas decorations each week and explaining their origins. Since many (or all) will still be coming to worship via ZOOM you are invited to join in the worship by adding new decorations in your home matching the new elements in the sanctuary. They don't have to be fancy or large. One could even collect all the pieces in a bowl or basket and just get it out for Sunday. The first decoration will be the Advent Wreath. Some are very elaborate, but in essence it is 5 candles, the fifth one is usually larger and saved for Christmas Eve. The tradition is 3 purple or blue candles and one pink (3rd Sunday of Advent) but you can use any colors or even just white. The Sundays in December we will find out about the greens, mistletoe, holly, the Christmas tree, Poinsettias, and the Nativity scene. Jude and I look forward to sharing this season of waiting and watching with you. Somehow it is even more significant this year as we all await a vaccine and an end to the effects Covid has had on our lives. May God bless us with hope and patience this Advent Season.

### When are we going to have church in person?

At the October meeting the council gave tentative approval to inviting 10-15 people to attend worship in person in a socially distanced way starting in Advent (November 29). As Council continues to monitor the local COVID numbers and any impact it might have on meeting in person, this remains tentative and a final decision will be made by Council when they meet in November. No matter the decision, we will continue to have virtual worship on ZOOM. The platform **may** change once we have a vaccine, and we open up completely. But please be assured we will always have church on-line from here on out. Many of us have gone through periods where we have had to stay away from large crowds, and we want to minister to everyone. Faith has also been blessed with some wonderful new folks during this time of virtual worship. Our online presence allows us to both support our friends at home and increase our chance to minister to those around the world.



## Faith United Church of Christ Council Meeting Minutes 10-19-20

In attendance: Richard Dilts, Pastor Brian Bagley-Bonner, Pastor Judy Bagley Bonner, Sylvia Hull, Ken Followell, Vicky Followell, Barbara Brownell, PJ Widerman, Amy Van Dell, Linda Van Buskirk, Marge Kirchner, Judy Wetter, Faith Quici

Pastor Brian opened the meeting in prayer at 6:32pm.

A motion was made by Judy Wetter to approve the minutes as printed in the October Faithful Follower. It was seconded by Marge Kirchner. The motion was carried.

Treasurer and Financial Secretary reports were looked over and discussed. We have more givers who have been attending online via Zoom, thus our numbers at this current time are better than they were last year during the same time. The financial reports will be presented to council in an easier to read format. A date will be decided on soon for council members to attend and be trained on how to read and understand all financial reports in full.

A motion was made by PJ Widerman to approve the Aug and Sept financial reports and it was seconded by Sylvia Hull. The motion was carried.

The church calendars were reviewed.

Pastor Brian reported there has been positive feedback on the latest in person coffee talk. The coffee talk schedule for Oct 21 has been cancelled due to low sign up. The coffee talk scheduled for Oct 28 is half way filled with reservations. A new coffee talk is scheduled for Nov 13 at 10 am at Scott and Babs Brownell's home. We have 12 invites out for the new member's class on Oct 25. The pastors met with Leslie Etherdge, of the UCC conference, who gave affirming words about the new people from Sun City who would like join our church. The recent book study has been going well.

### **Old Business:**

There was a discussion about opening with in person services and when. At this time we will not have in person services for the month of November. However there is a possibility of opening in a safe way (minimal attendance through reservations, masks, social distancing, sanitizing, no singing...etc) possible start date would be the last Sunday in November and through the Advent season with minimal Sanctuary decorations and services being broadcast in the Sanctuary while also continuing on Zoom at the same time. A final decision will be made at the next council meeting and will be based on how the COVID numbers for our region will be when that date approaches.

We were informed that the NA/NarAnon groups are not following CDC guidelines that are posted at the church. They will be reminded of the CDC guidelines, given disinfecting materials and asked to clean afterwards. A representative of the church council will be present after their meeting to monitor. This will give them a chance to

continue to meet here. A meeting will be set up with the NA representative - Richard Geib, Richard Dilts and Pastor Brian to communicate the expectations to the NA/NarAnon groups meeting in the building and find out their needs as well.

There was a brief discussion about the HOA's meeting in person at the building. The council has decided not to grant permission for the HOA's to use our building to meet in person at this time.

#### Media Update:

A contact of Ken Followell assessed the needs to distribute the new internet connection throughout our building. This is an approximate cost of \$2,415. Pastor Brian was advised to apply for a matching grant through the UCC to help with the media update expense. The information about our options with Frontier and Spectrum were reviewed and discussed. Faith will look into the cost of upgrading the phone system and getting new phones.

A motion was made by Marge Kirchner to switch from Frontier to Spectrum as a communications carrier for the church. PJ Widerman seconded it and the motion was carried.

With the church relying more on technology, there is a need for more help in this area. A few ideas and suggestions were made by Pastor Brian on how to solve the work load in this area and delegate some of the responsibilities. No decisions on a solution were made at this time.

#### **New Business:**

Nominations for council positions for 2021 were discussed.

Events and Fellowship – Amy reported the first in person coffee went well and she will be at the next.

Faith Care – Ken mentioned he still needs drivers to take members to doctor's apt. etc. The need is especially for the West side of Bradenton.

Worship – Sylvia reported that people are signing up for scripture readers through Faith.

Community Outreach - Linda had no report.

Property – PJ thanked everyone who helped on the outside cleanup. There are plans in the works for the Memorial Garden including tree trimming to have a beautiful line of sight. The next big project is to raise the parking bumpers and paint them.

SAM – Babs asked Brian to mention the Food Bank whenever possible, they are in desperate need. Blanket Sunday has been rescheduled until after the first of the year. The Kiwanis club is still packing meals but are not using outside help. Monetary donations are greatly appreciated.

Pastor Brian closed the meeting with prayer at 8:45pm.
